HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY FOR TVET COURSES

To apply for a TVET course you need to complete an 'Expression of Interest' (EOI) form. Once you have filled in this form, there is a section to be completed by your parent/guardian and by your school. Your school will submit your EOI on your behalf. It is important that all sections are completed and signed by all parties. Incomplete forms could jeopardise a place in the class. Offers of placement will be made through your school in Term 4.
