- Surveys for mining Using satellite information to monitor the earth's surface
- Measuring continental drift or rising sea levels

CERTIFICATE III SURVEYING AND SPATIAL **INFORMATION SERVICES**

CPP30216

This program is for people seeking an entry point into the surveying and spatial information services sector and incorporates the gathering, retrieval, storage and use of spatial information.

Included in this sector are organisations involved with CAD drafting, mapping, surveying, land administration and geographic information systems (GIS). Completion of this Certificate III leads into the Certificate IV of Surveying course.

CERTIFICATE IV SURVEYING

CPP40216

This course is for people seeking to become surveying assistants. You will learn about collecting, storing and retrieving spatial data, reading and interpreting basic image data, collecting and setting out basic survey data, operating survey data equipment and performing surveying computations.

You will also learn about producing computer aided drawings. Completion of this Certificate IV leads into the Diploma of Surveying course.

DIPLOMA SURVEYING

CPP50116

This course is for people seeking to become surveying technicians and prepares you for a range of specifications, such as land surveying, engineering surveying and mining surveying. You will learn about geographic information systems, computer aided drafting, use of surveying equipment software packages, sub-division design and land title surveys.
